SUBJECT: FACULTY REGULATIONS - Chapter VIII - Section 13 GRADUATION

SECTION 13. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION FROM THE COLLEGE OF FINE ARTS

CANDIDATES FOR THE B.F.A., B. MUS., AND B.A. DEGREES MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST 183 CREDIT HOURS OF WORK APPROVED BY THE DEAN AND THE FACULTY OF THE COLLEGE. THE 183 HOURS MUST INCLUDE THE SUBJECT REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 4 OF THIS CHAPTER AND NOT FEWER THAN 36 CREDIT HOURS OF WORK IN THE MAJOR. STUDENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF FINE ARTS MUST MAJOR IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING FIELDS OF CONCENTRATION: ART, BALLET, MODERN DANCE, MUSIC, OR THEATRE. THE B.A. DEGREE MAY BE AWARDED ONLY TO STUDENTS WHO MAJOR IN ART, MUSIC OR THEATRE HISTORY, SATISFY THE LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE B.A. DEGREE, COMPLETE A MINIMUM OF 48 CREDIT HOURS IN ALLIED FIELDS OUTSIDE THEIR MAJOR DEPARTMENT AS APPROVED BY THE FACULTY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ART, AND PASS A WRITTEN COMPREHENSIVE EXAMINATION.
