Subject: FACULTY REGULATIONS - Chapter X AMENDMENTS

SECTION I.

Legislation adding to or amending the Faculty Regulations may be enacted as follows: At least two weeks' notice of any proposed legislation must be given at a regular meeting of the Academic Senate. The required notice period may be waived if specifically requested by any number of the Academic Senate and consented to by a two-thirds vote of a quorum of the Academic Senate. If notice is waived, the proposed legislation may be called up for immediate consideration and enactment.

Unless notice is waived, a copy of the proposed legislation shall be filed with the secretary of the Academic Senate who will include it with the agenda for the next meeting of the senate. The proposed legislation shall be received before the Academic Senate as a motion duly seconded.

All additions and amendments to the Faculty Regulations shall take effect immediately, except that legislation which specifies an effective date will take effect on that specified date.
