Guidelines for Proposals for Graduate Emphases related to Policy 6-225

The following revised Guidelines were approved by the Graduate Council on March 29, 2010.

- 1. Proposals should explain how the emphasis is a coherent area of focus, and how the students' engagement in the emphasis will lead to mastery of a distinctive body of knowledge or research method.
- 2. Proposals should clarify how the emphasis references explanatory terminology that is useful and recognized outside of the University of Utah, e.g., in employment certifications or graduate school applications.
- 3. Proposals should address how completing the requirements for the emphasis will affect the number of credit hours required for the degree.
- 4. Proposals must include a letter from the pertinent dean supporting the transcripting of the emphasis.
