SUBJECT: FACULTY REGULATIONS - Chapter VIII - Section 9 GRADUATION

SECTION 9. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION WITH A BACHELOR OF UNIVERSITY STUDIES DEGREE

THE BACHELOR OF UNIVERSITY STUDIES PROGRAM, ADMINISTERED BY THE UNIVERSITY STUDIES COMMITTEE, PERMITS A STUDENT IN CONSULTATION WITH A FACULTY ADVISER TO PLAN AN INDIVIDUALIZED PROGRAM OF STUDY NOT OFFERED AS A MAJOR IN ANY ACADEMIC DEPARTMENT. THE GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 4 ABOVE, APPLY TO THE B.U.S. DEGREE, WITH TWO EXCEPTIONS: (1) A MINIMUM OF 85 UPPER DIVISION HOURS IS REQUIRED; (2) THE LIBERAL EDUCATION PROGRAM OF THE UNIVERSITY IS NOT REQUIRED. SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR THE B.U.S. DEGREE ARE SET FORTH IN THE UNIVERSITY CATALOG.
