SUBJECT: FACULTY REGULATIONS - Chapter VIII - Section 10 GRADUATION

SECTION 10. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION FROM THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS

CANDIDATES FOR THE B.A. OR B.S. DEGREE MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST 183 CREDIT HOURS OF WORK APPROVED BY THE DEAN AND THE FACULTY OF THE COLLEGE. AT LEAST 60 OF THESE HOURS MUST BE UPPER DIVISION.

TO SECURE PROPER CONCENTRATION AS WELL AS DISTRIBUTION OF STUDIES, CANDIDATES FOR THE B.A. OR B.S. DEGREE MUST HAVE COMPLETED THE LIBERAL EDUCATION COURSE REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 4 OF THIS CHAPTER AND 90 OR MORE CREDIT HOURS IN THE MAJOR AND ALLIED FIELDS OF CONCENTRATION AS PRESCRIBED BY THE FACULTY OF THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS. THE ALLIED SUBJECTS SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT CHAIRPERSON AND THE DEAN.
