SECTION 12. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION FROM THE COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING

CANDIDATES FOR THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN THE COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING MUST COMPLETE A COURSE PROGRAM OF AT LEAST 183 CREDIT HOURS OF WORK APPROVED BY THE DEAN AND THE FACULTY OF THE COLLEGE, INCLUDING THE SUBJECT REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 4 OF THIS CHAPTER.

STUDENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING MUST MAJOR IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING DEPARTMENTS: CHEMICAL ENGINEERING, CIVIL ENGINEERING, COMPUTER SCIENCE, ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING, MATERIALS SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING, OR MECHANICAL AND INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING.
