SUBJECT: FACULTY REGULATIONS - Chapter VIII - Section 17 GRADUATION

SECTION 17. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION FROM THE COLLEGE OF NURSING

A CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING MUST COMPLETE THE PROFESSIONAL COURSES PRESCRIBED BY THE COLLEGE OF NURSING AND THE LIBERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED BY THE UNIVERSITY SO THAT THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CREDIT HOURS WILL BE A MINIMUM OF 183 CREDIT HOURS. THE PROFESSIONAL COURSES IN THE COLLEGE OF NURSING SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE APPROPRIATE ORGANIZATIONAL CURRICULAR STRUCTURE IN THE COLLEGE. A CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING MUST HAVE A GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF AT LEAST 2.00 IN ALL MAJOR COURSE WORK.
