Appendix A: Definition of Satisfactory for TFR Statement

In response to the changes in the Tenured Faculty Review procedures, the Department of World Languages and Cultures have proposed the following definitions of "satisfactory" for Tenured Faculty Reviews.

- **Research:** There is evidence of an active research profile and the candidate has made acceptable contributions in one or more topic areas.
- **Teaching:** The candidate has made acceptable contributions in the areas of course instruction, curriculum / program development, and student advising and mentoring.
- **Service:** The candidate has made acceptable contributions in the area of service, defined as a minimum requirement of two service activities per teaching year.

These definitions are the same or modeled after the definitions of "effective" in the current Retention, Promotion, and Tenure (RPT) statement.

The Tenure-line faculty in the department approved the proposed language with a vote of 26 yes, 0 no, and 4 absent.
